Types of items accepted:

- Household paints, stains, dyes
- Floor wax, floor care products, carpet cleaner
- Furniture polish, bathroom cleaners, stain removers, solvents
- Medicine (non-controlled substances only)
- Nail polish, glue
- Fertilizer, lawn and garden chemicals, pesticides
- Antifreeze, motor oil, gasoline, propane tanks
- Automotive batteries, dry cell batteries, fluorescent bulbs (all types)
- Fire extinguishers, smoke detectors
- Mercury thermometers, thermostats, elemental mercury
- Computer CPU's, flat screen monitors, printers, keyboards, mice
- Cell phones, fax machines, copiers
- CRT televisions, CRT monitors

Types of items NOT accepted:

- Radioactive material (anything that glows in the dark)
- Explosives, ammunition
- Household waste, yard waste, commercial waste, industrial waste
- Tires
- Appliances (refrigerators, microwaves)
- Roofing, shingles, concrete
